

Safety Instructions

- If you're working with kids increase the measures 1cm to 2 cm, 1,5 cm to 2,5 cm.



Materials & Tools

- Fabric: 40x90 cm + 28x70 cm we recomend fabric without elasticity and have in mind that a thicker fabric is harder for he machine to sew.
- Fabric marker / watercolor pencil
- Sewing machine
- needle
- thread
- Overlock machine (optional)
- Laser cutter, can be replaced with scissors
- Iron
- Pins

Step by step instructions

Process overview

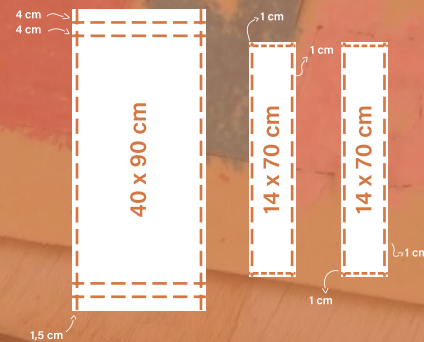
- Step 1: Cut the fabric
- Step 2: Measure
- Step 3: Iron
- Step 4: Sew the strips
- Step 5: Sew the main piece
- Step 6: Close the bag
- Step 7: Sew (Close the bag)
- Step 8: Join the pieces

Step 1: Cut the Fabric

- If you're going to cut the pieces in the laser you have to create and get ready the design, cut them in the machine or by hand.

Step 2: Measure

- Determine the lines we will be sewing, with a ruler, you can mark with a fabric marker or with a pencil, remember to put the marks inside the fabric



Step 3: Iron

- Iron the lines you just created, fold it to the inside of the fabric.

Step 4: Sew the strips

- Start with the strips (piece B and B1).
- Fold in 2 each piece, you can hold the fabric with some pins.

Step 5: Sew the Main Piece

- Fold to the inside part the 2 lines you create at the top and bottom of the piece A.

Tip: Sew by the orange line

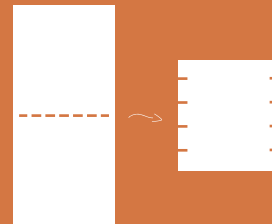


Step 6: Close the Bag

- Fold to the inside the piece the piece A.

Step 7: Sew (Close the Bag)

- Sew 2 lines according the blue lines.
- Just to make the life of your tote longer, sew with zig-zag or with overlock the extremes, (paralello to the llast 2 lines you sew).



Step 8: Join the Pieces

- Chossing one of the next figures, sew the strips to the main bag, leavinga separation of at least 12 cm between them.
