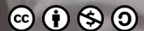
- Pay attention to the fact that the image when printed is mirrored.

# I Sanded my T-shirt and Tote Bag

Create your own design for your T-shirt or Tote Bag

# Materials & Tools



1. Sandpaper sheet
2. Shemakes logo laser cut on sandpaper sheet
3. Iron
4. T-shirt or Tote bag (or any other textile as long as it's cotton)
5. Crayons
6. Sheet of paper, scissors and pencil
7. Newspaper sheet
8. Piece of cardboard

# I Sanded my T-shirt and Tote Bag

## Step by step instructions

### Process overview

- Step 1: Make a sketch
- Step 2: Paint the sandpaper
- Step 3: Card
- Step 4: Sandpaper
- Step 5: Newspaper sheet
- Step 6: Remove the newspaper sheet

### Step 1: Make a sketch

- Make a sketch of what you want to draw on the sandpaper, on a white sheet, taking into account the mirror effect.



### Step 2: Paint the Sandpaper

- Paint the sandpapers (shemakes logo and personal drawing) with crayons. Note that you need to press down hard so that there is enough ink on the sandpaper to transfer to the fabric.



### Step 3: Card

- Place a card in the middle of the T-shirt/Tote bag so that there is no transfer from one side of the shirt to the other.



### Step 4: Sandpaper

- Place the sandpaper on the t-shirt/ tote bag, in the desired place, with the design facing down.



### Step 5: Newspaper sheet

- Place a sheet of newspaper on top and iron for one minute.



### Step 6: Remove the newspaper sheet

- Remove the newspaper sheet and then carefully "peel" the sandpaper off the fabric..



The print is ready!
